2200 Souls in Tanzania!!



On August 26 to September 4 Dr David and Sherry Nichols traveled to Chato, Tanzania for a gospel festival. During the five nights of the festival meetings, 2200 people stepped forward to repent and give their lives to Jesus. Many people were healed of conditions of pain in their bodies, and hundreds were delivered from evil spirits. Two notable miracles arrested the attention of the people

of Chato. The first was the miraculous healing of a man who was barely able to convey himself forward on his crutches. He had a broken leg with complications. As we were taking testimonies from others who had been healed, the power of God hit this man and healed his leg. He began walking in front of our platform with another man holding his crutches over his head. Word spread quickly, and people began streaming out of their houses onto the field to see this man. Our crowd nearly doubled in size in ten minutes. Hundreds of people repented that night as the altar call was given. The next night a young man about 20 years old who was born deaf was healed. His ears popped open and he began to speak with vocal chords that had never been used since his birth. This miracle also made a huge impact on the town. In fact, weeks after the festival, people were still coming to see the young man and hear him speak. The pastors were still ready, influencing the people to follow Jesus.

Cell Phone Healings in Wisconsin

On August 22 and 23 Dr David Nichols ministered at a conference hosted by Valley Harvest Church in Menasha, WI. Several people were healed over the cell phones as members of the crowd called people who had needs. A man scheduled for bilateral knee surgery was healed in Duluth, MN; a woman in eastern MN was delivered from a spirit of fear; Pastor/Apostle Bidal Torrez called his father, who was healed as the peace of God came over him. Kingdom Transformation

One of the great truths of the Kingdom of Heaven is that it changes everything with which it has a true encounter. In Matthew 13:44 Jesus shows this truth by telling of a man finding treasure hidden in a field. For joy, he sells everything he has and buys the field. This loving, reigning power and authority of Jesus that we call the Kingdom of God has that effect. The man in this similitude certainly was transformed to the point that he sold all in order to gain what was hidden in the field. Jesus' actions often speak just as loudly as His words.

Jesus shows this transforming power of the Kingdom in another way in Matthew chapter 4. He begins walking by the Sea of Gallilee. There He finds two sets of brothers who were fishermen. He said to them: "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men!" No one knew what a fisher of men was- they had only seen fishers of fish. But when the King brought the Kingdom into the presence of fishermen, there was a transformation. Before they fished for fish, but now they would join Jesus and fish for men.

The supreme act of redemption, the cross of Calvary, also shows the transforming power of the Kingdom of Heaven. In the ancient Roman world, before Jesus' death, no one thought of a cross as a symbol of salvation or healing or anything good. A cross meant someone had done a serious crime against the laws of Rome, and now they were sentenced to one of the cruelest forms of torture ever devised by man. There was great shame associated with being crucified. The victim usually hung naked, sometimes for days in the burning sun. The Romans had actually lined certain roads leading into Gallilee with crosses so that everyone was reminded often of the potential consequences of rebelling against Roman rule. But the day Jesus died, a Kingdom greater than Rome encountered the reality of the cross. The King of this Kingdom poured out His lifeblood. But in this encounter, the Kingdom transformed the cross from a symbol of horrific torture to a symbol of salvation and freedom from sin.

These are certainly days of harvest in the natural world, but even more so in the spiritual world. We will be harvesting again in Rukomo, Rwanda on December 4-7. We will conduct a gospel festival in this village with thousands coming to Christ as Savior. Then on Sunday, December 8, we will hold a gospel seminar for business and government leaders. The prime minister of Rwanda has been invited, and may attend. We believe the future of the nation will be impacted by the power of the Holy Spirit. From there, we will travel to Uganda to speak to 2000 pastors for four days in Kampala. The Lord of the harvest has recently stirred our hearts afresh to reach thousands of people [here in America](#) through gospel festivals in towns and cities all over America.
