2300 Souls in Tanzania!

There is a power in the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ that cannot be contained or defeated. That power is the ability to change human lives from darkness to light,



from salvation. We sent a team into Tanzania in June, under the leadership of David Dewes They overcame many obstacles to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to thousands the village of Relini. During this amazing

trip, 2300 people repented of their sins and took Jesus as their Savior and Lord. In addition to the crusade, the team also ministered to 800 Tanzanian youth at a conference in the city of Mwanza. Another feature of this trip was the dedication of water wells in two other villages. These are places where the women search for ever-decreasing pond water in the dry season for their families' needs. These wells become a center of the village's life and activity. At one of the villages, during the dedication, our preacher proclaimed the Gospel from John chapter 4. He declared that the water from this well can satisfy your physical thirst, but living water is available, leading to eternal life. At the altar call, 200 repented and received Jesus as Savior. In the picture below, people are waving palm branches in celebration of the water, both physical and spiritual.

Revival includes many different activities of the Holy Spirit. At The Church @ New Bern in New Bern, NC, many people received the joy of the Lord. A Sampling of the Healings in Tanzania

A 6-month-old baby could not see, now healed by the name of Jesus. A six-year-old girl who was blind now sees. A woman who had to use crutches and canes for four years walked across the stage with no support. A tumor dissolved from the left side abdomen of a young woman. Another young woman was delivered from nightmares of people chasing her. A three-year-long condition of pain in the back, legs, and arms was completely healed. They will conduct a 5-day crusade that will cost \$5000, and they will dedicate a well that will cost \$9500. These wells become the site for a church building which can be built for \$5500.
